BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16 **Article - Education** 17 13-509. The EMS Board may adopt regulations that assure that helicopters 18 (d) (1) 19 transporting patients between hospitals or to or from specialty centers notify the 20 System's communication center in the State Emergency Medical Communications 21 System. 22 ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2004, THE EMS BOARD SHALL ADOPT (I) (2) 23 REGULATIONS THAT PROVIDE FOR THE INTER-FACILITY HELICOPTER TRANSPORT 24 OF PATIENTS BY LICENSED PRIVATE HELICOPTER CARRIERS. 25 (II)THE REGULATIONS SHALL SPECIFY:

- 4 MARYLAND STATE POLICE MEDEVAC HELICOPTER MAY PROVIDE THE TRANSPORT.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 July 1, 2003.
