- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (c) Any person who, with the consent of the owner, has custody of a
- 16 motor vehicle and who, at the request of the owner, provides a service to or materials
- 17 for the motor vehicle, has a lien on the motor vehicle for any charge incurred for any:
- 18 (i) Repair or rebuilding;
- 19 (ii) Storage OR TOWING; or
- 20 (iii) Tires or other parts or accessories.
- 21 (2) A lien is created under this subsection when any charges set out
- 22 under paragraph (1) of this subsection giving rise to the lien are incurred.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 October 1, 2003.
