## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT cor	ncerning
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- 2 Creation of a State Debt Wicomico County Boulevard Theatre Performing
  Arts Complex
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$500,000,
- 5 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Salisbury
- 6 Wicomico Arts Council for certain development or improvement purposes;
- 7 providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that
- 8 the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; requiring the grantee to grant
- 9 a certain easement to the Maryland Historical Trust; and providing generally for
- the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

## 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 12 MARYLAND, That:
- 13 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 14 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Wicomico
- 15 County Boulevard Theatre Performing Arts Complex Loan of 2003 in a total
- 16 principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$500,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching
- 17 fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by
- 18 the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a
- 19 resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance
- 20 with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and
- 21 Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 22 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 23 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 24 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 25 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 26 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 27 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 28 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 29 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 30 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Salisbury
- 31 Wicomico Arts Council (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the
- 32 design, construction, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the

- 1 Boulevard Theatre to be converted into a performing arts complex, located in 2 Salisbury.
- 3 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 4 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 5 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 6 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 7 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 8 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 9 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 10 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 11 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of funds expended prior to the
- 12 effective date of this Act. The fund may consist of real property and in kind
- 13 contributions. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what
- 14 money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall
- 15 determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1,
- 16 2005, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching
- 17 fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this
- 18 fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of
- 19 the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes
- 20 provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching
- 21 fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further
- 22 effect.
- 23 (6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey
- 24 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of
- 25 its interest:
- 26 (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- 27 and
- 28 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
- 29 structures.
- 30 (b) If the grantee or beneficiary of the grant holds a lease on the land
- 31 and structures, the Trust may accept an easement on the leasehold interest.
- 32 (c) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust
- 33 and any liens or encumbrances against the land or the structures must be acceptable
- 34 to the Trust.
- 35 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 36 June 1, 2003.
