1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Retirement and Pensions - Baltimore City Child Support Enforcement**
3 **Employees**

4 FOR the purpose of providing a certain amount of service credit to certain State
5 employees who were formerly employed by a private vendor to provide child
6 support enforcement services in Baltimore City; requiring certain State
7 employees to deposit a certain amount of money into a certain fund; reducing
8 certain retirees' allowances if a certain amount of money is not deposited into a
9 certain fund; and generally relating to service credit for certain members of the
10 State Retirement and Pension System who were employed by a private vendor
11 to provide child support enforcement services in Baltimore City.

2 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

6 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A MEMBER OF THE EMPLOYEES'
7 RETIREMENT SYSTEM WHO:

8 (1) WAS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE STATE PRIOR TO NOVEMBER 1, 1996;

9 (2) AS OF NOVEMBER 1, 1996 WAS EMPLOYED BY A PRIVATE VENDOR TO
10 PROVIDE CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT SERVICES IN BALTIMORE CITY; AND

11 (3) RESUMED EMPLOYMENT WITH THE STATE AS OF NOVEMBER 1, 2002.

9 (C) (1) A MEMBER DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS

11 EMPLOYED BY A PRIVATE VENDOR TO PROVIDE CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT
12 SERVICES IN BALTIMORE CITY FROM JULY 1, 1998 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2002.

13 (2) ~~ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 2008~~ PRIOR TO RETIREMENT, AND SUBJECT
14 TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A MEMBER WHO RECEIVES SERVICE
15 CREDIT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL DEPOSIT IN THE ANNUITY SAVINGS FUND
16 OR OTHER CORRESPONDING FUND AN AMOUNT OF MONEY EQUAL TO THE
17 CONTRIBUTION PAYMENTS THAT THE MEMBER ~~AND THE EMPLOYER~~ WOULD HAVE
18 PAID HAD THE MEMBER BEEN A STATE EMPLOYEE, INCLUDING REGULAR INTEREST
19 ON THE CONTRIBUTIONS AT THE RATE OF 5% PER YEAR COMPOUNDED ANNUALLY.

20 (3) ON RETIREMENT, THE MEMBER'S RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE SHALL
21 BE REDUCED BY THE ACTUARIAL EQUIVALENT OF THE AMOUNT DETERMINED
22 UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION IF THE MEMBER ELECTS NOT TO
23 DEPOSIT THIS AMOUNT IN THE ANNUITY SAVINGS OR OTHER CORRESPONDING
24 FUND.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
26 effect July 1, 2003.
