- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection or as otherwise
- 19 specifically provided by statute, a person eighteen years of age or more is an adult for
- 20 all purposes whatsoever and has the same legal capacity, rights, powers, privileges,
- 21 duties, liabilities, and responsibilities as prior to July 1, 1973, persons had at
- 22 twenty-one years of age, and the "age of majority" is hereby declared to be eighteen
- 23 years.
- 24 (2) A person who has attained the age of 18 years and who is enrolled in
- 25 secondary school has the right to receive support and maintenance from both of the
- 26 person's parents until the first to occur of the following events:
- 27 (i) The person dies;
