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

HOUSE BILL 825 1 A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE TO COVER GENERAL LIABILITY 2 INSURANCE FOR THE ELEVATOR UNIT. 3 THE COMMISSIONER SHALL VERIFY THE QUALIFICATIONS, 4 LICENSING, AND PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE OF THE LICENSED 5 MECHANICAL ENGINEER WHO CONDUCTS THE INSPECTION OF AN ELEVATOR UNIT 6 ON PRIVATE PROPERTY REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION. 7 12-810. [The Commissioner shall conduct] THERE SHALL BE a final acceptance 8 (a) 9 inspection on completion of the installation of an elevator unit before it is placed in 10 service. 11 The Commissioner shall provide an inspection checklist that specifies the 12 requirements for compliance with the Safety Code and other regulations adopted by 13 the Commissioner. 14 Before scheduling a final acceptance inspection [with the (c) 15 Commissioner] for an elevator unit being installed in the State, the contractor shall 16 ensure that: 17 the elevator unit meets the requirements of the Safety Code and (1) 18 other regulations adopted by the Commissioner; and 19 the elements indicated on the inspection checklist are operational, (2)20 have been tested, and are functional. 21 If an inspector arrives to inspect an elevator unit at the designated time 22 and the elevator unit does not meet the criteria established in subsection (c) of this 23 section, the inspector may cancel the inspection and charge the contractor a fee in 24 accordance with § 12-809 of this subtitle. 25 12-811. 26 If an inspection OR INSPECTION CERTIFICATION discloses that an elevator (a) 27 unit complies with the Safety Code and other regulations adopted by the 28 Commissioner, the Commissioner shall issue a certificate to the owner or lessee of the 29 elevator unit. 30 The certificate shall be posted conspicuously in or on the elevator unit. (b) While a certificate is in effect, it authorizes the holder to operate the 31 (c) 32 elevator unit in a building, structure, or place of employment in the State. 33 12-812. 34 A certificate expires 1 year after its effective date. [The Commissioner shall conduct] THERE SHALL BE an annual inspection

36 of each elevator unit to determine whether to reissue the certificate.

- 1 Before scheduling an annual inspection [with the Commissioner], the (c) 2 contractor, owner, or lessee of an elevator unit shall: 3 ensure that the elevator unit is operated, inspected, and repaired in 4 accordance with Part II of this subtitle and the regulations adopted under Part II of 5 this subtitle; and make inspection, maintenance, and repair records available to the 6 7 inspector charged with inspecting the elevator unit. When an [inspector conducts an] annual inspection IS CONDUCTED 8 9 and the elevator unit fails the inspection, [the inspector shall issue] an inspection 10 checklist SHALL BE ISSUED that specifies the corrections required. 11 The inspection checklist shall be on a form provided by the 12 Commissioner and shall specify the requirements for compliance with the Safety Code and other regulations adopted by the Commissioner. 14 If a follow-up inspection is required to ensure compliance with the (3) 15 corrections specified on the inspection checklist, the contractor, owner, or lessee shall 16 pay a fee in accordance with § 12-809 of this subtitle. 17 12-813. 18 (a) If [an inspector cancels] a final acceptance inspection under § 12-810 of 19 this subtitle IS CANCELLED or if a follow-up inspection is required under § 12-812 of 20 this subtitle, the contractor, owner, or lessee of the elevator unit shall: 21 (1) reschedule the inspection [with the inspector]; and 22 ensure that the elevator unit complies with the requirements of Part 23 II of this subtitle, including correcting as necessary any safety hazards or violations of 24 the Safety Code, on the designated date. 25 A contractor, owner, or lessee shall maintain a copy of any inspection, 26 maintenance, and repair records at a central location in a manner consistent with 27 regulations adopted under Part II of this subtitle. 28 12-814. 29 (a) When an inspection discloses that an elevator unit is in unsafe condition so 30 that its continued operation will violate the Safety Code, or any other regulation 31 adopted by the Commissioner under Part II of this subtitle, a citation may be issued 32 and penalties may be assessed in accordance with §§ 5-212 and 5-213 of the Labor 33 and Employment Article.


