## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Regulated Firearms - Report of Loss or Theft

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the owner of a regulated firearm, within a certain
- 4 period of time, to report to the Secretary of State Police the loss or theft of the
- 5 firearm; making it a crime to fail to report the loss or theft; setting penalties in
- 6 violation of this Act; and generally relating to lost or stolen firearms.

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Public Safety
- 15 5-144.
- 16 (A) IF A REGULATED FIREARM IS LOST OR STOLEN, THE OWNER OF THE
- 17 REGULATED FIREARM SHALL REPORT THE LOSS OR THEFT TO THE SECRETARY
- 18 WITHIN 48 HOURS AFTER BECOMING AWARE OF THE LOSS OR THEFT.
- 19 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 20 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A
- 21 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 23 October 1, 2003.
