

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 24 (2) "Bona fide intrafamily transfer" means a transfer to a member of the
- 25 owner's immediate family of a portion of the owner's property for the purpose of
- 26 establishing a residence for that family member.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be 16 construed to apply to the initial development of the [Young Men's Christian 17 Association facility located as follows: Starting at a point in Worcester County at the 18 intersection of Gum Point Road and the Wilkerson-Steen property line, proceeding 19 north to the Caffi-Steen line, following on to the Park-Steen line, on to the 20 Chamberlain-Steen line, to the Parsons-Steen line, to the Wyatt-Steen line, at which 21 point the line turns east on the Wyatt-Steen line, turning north at the Wyatt-Steen 22 boundary line to the Ocean Pines Association-Steen southern boundary line with 23 Ocean Pines, then turning east along the Ocean Pines-Steen line to the northern 24 stream and ditch at Mud Creek, then follows the stream and ditch to Gum Point 25 Road, then along Gum Point Road to the starting point] PROPERTY IN THE THIRD TAX 26 DISTRICT OF WORCESTER COUNTY DEPICTED ON WORCESTER COUNTY TAX MAP 21 27 ON A PORTION OF WHICH A YOUNG MEN'S CHRISTIAN ASSOCIATION FACILITY IS TO 28 BE LOCATED, WHICH PROPERTY IS IDENTIFIED AS FOLLOWS: STARTING ON THE 29 NORTHERLY LINE OF GUM POINT ROAD AT THE POINT WHERE IT INTERSECTS WITH 30 THE LINE BETWEEN THE LANDS OF HARRY WILKERSON (PARCEL 135) AND STEEN 31 ASSOCIATES, INC. (PARCEL 134); THEN NORTHERLY ALONG THE WESTERLY LINE OF 32 THE STEEN PROPERTY (PARCELS 134 AND 118) AND THE EASTERLY LINE OF THE 33 LANDS OF HARRY WILKERSON, VENERANDO CAFFI (PARCEL 34), OAK-KWANG PARK 34 (PARCEL 15), CLINTON CHAMBERLAIN (PARCEL 207) AND GEORGE PARSONS (PARCEL 35 72) TO THE LANDS OF JAMES WYATT (PARCEL 66); THEN BY AND WITH THE WYATT 36 PROPERTY SOUTHEASTERLY AND NORTHERLY TO LANDS CONSTITUTING OCEAN

40 ALONG GUM POINT ROAD TO THE STARTING POINT.

42 (1) Section 5 of this Act shall take effect only if, on or before July 1, 2003:

37 PINES SECTION 10 THEN EASTERLY ALONG THE SOUTHERLY LINE OF OCEAN PINES 38 SECTION 10 TO A DITCH AT THE HEADWATERS OF MUD CREEK; THEN BY AND WITH 39 MUD CREEK TO THE NORTHERLY LINE OF GUM POINT ROAD; THEN WESTERLY

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	(i) THE YOUNG MEN'S CHRISTIAN ASSOCIATION HAS ACQUIRED THAT PORTION OF the property described under Section 5 of this Act DESIGNATED FOR ITS FACILITY [has been acquired by the Young Men's Christian Association]; and
4	(ii) three of the four following State permits are issued to the YMCA:
5	1. groundwater discharge or surface water discharge;
6	2. nontidal wetlands;
7	3. water quality certification; and
8	4. water appropriation; and
11	(2) If the events described under paragraph (1) of this section do not occur on or before July 1, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, Section 5 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect after July 1, 2003.
	(3) If the events described under paragraph (1) of this section occur, the property remains subject to the growth allocation provisions of the Critical Area law and regulations.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 17 effect June 1, 2003.
