- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

1 (c) The Board consists of: 2 [Nine] SEVEN voting members jointly appointed by the Mayor of (1) 3 Baltimore City and the Governor; [and] 4 (2) EIGHT VOTING MEMBERS ELECTED AS FOLLOWS: ONE MEMBER ELECTED FROM THE CITY AT LARGE BY THE 5 (I) VOTERS OF BALTIMORE CITY; (II) ONE MEMBER ELECTED FROM BOARD OF EDUCATION DISTRICT 7 8 1; ONE MEMBER ELECTED FROM BOARD OF EDUCATION DISTRICT 9 (III)10 2; 11 (IV) ONE MEMBER ELECTED FROM BOARD OF EDUCATION DISTRICT 12 3; 13 (V) ONE MEMBER ELECTED FROM BOARD OF EDUCATION DISTRICT 14 4; ONE MEMBER ELECTED FROM BOARD OF EDUCATION DISTRICT 15 (VI) 16 5; 17 (VII) ONE MEMBER ELECTED FROM BOARD OF EDUCATION DISTRICT 18 6; 19 (VIII) ONE MEMBER ELECTED FROM BOARD OF EDUCATION DISTRICT 20 7; AND 21 [One] TWO voting student [member] MEMBERS appointed as (3) 22 provided in subsection (o) of this section. 23 Each member of the Board shall be a resident of Baltimore City. (d) To the extent practicable, the [membership] APPOINTED MEMBERS of the 24 (e) 25 Board shall reflect the demographic composition of Baltimore City. At least [four] THREE of the APPOINTED voting members shall possess a 26 27 high level of knowledge and expertise concerning the successful administration of a 28 large business, nonprofit, or governmental entity and shall have served in a high level 29 management position within such an entity. At least three of the APPOINTED voting members shall possess a high level 30 31 of knowledge and expertise concerning education.

At least one APPOINTED voting member shall be a parent of a student

1 Among the [nine] 15 voting members, at least one member shall also (i) (1) 2 possess knowledge or experience in the education of children with disabilities. The knowledge or experience may be derived from being the parent of 4 a child with a disability. The term of a voting member is [3] 4 years BEGINNING ON THE (1) 6 FIRST MONDAY IN DECEMBER AFTER THE MEMBER'S ELECTION OR APPOINTMENT 7 AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED OR APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES. The terms of the ELECTED voting members are staggered as required 8 9 [by the terms provided for members of the Board on June 1, 1997] UNDER 10 SUBSECTION (N) OF THIS SECTION. 11 At the end of a term, a voting member continues to serve until a 12 successor is appointed and qualifies. 13 A voting member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only 14 for the remainder of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. 15 A voting member may not serve more than two consecutive full (5)16 terms. To the extent practicable, the Governor and the Mayor shall fill any 17 18 vacancy on the Board within 60 days of the date of the vacancy. 19 THE GOVERNOR AND THE MAYOR SHALL APPOINT SEVEN MEMBERS 20 OF THE BOARD AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C)(1) OF THIS SECTION ON OR BEFORE 21 THE NOVEMBER 15, 2004 AND EVERY 4 YEARS THEREAFTER. 22 On the joint approval of the Mayor of Baltimore City and the Governor, a 23 member may be removed only for cause in accordance with § 3-108 of this subtitle. 24 (1) [Each member of the Board serves without compensation] THE (1) 25 CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE \$10,000 ANNUALLY AS 26 COMPENSATION AND THE OTHER VOTING MEMBERS ARE EACH ENTITLED TO 27 RECEIVE \$5,000 ANNUALLY AS COMPENSATION. VOTING MEMBERS ARE ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT, AFTER 28 29 SUBMITTING VOUCHERS, FOR TRAVEL AND OTHER EXPENSES. A STUDENT MEMBER MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION, BUT 30 31 AFTER SUBMITTING EXPENSE VOUCHERS, MAY BE REIMBURSED FOR TRAVEL AND
