- 26 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 27 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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## Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

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- 3 (A) The County Council of Montgomery County may remove any member of
- 4 the Commission appointed from Montgomery County. Removals may occur prior to
- 5 the expiration of the term for which they were appointed. [The County Executive of
- 6 Prince George's County may remove at his pleasure any members from that county
- 7 prior to the expiration of the term for which they were appointed, subject to the
- 8 approval of the County Council of Prince George's County by a vote of a majority of
- 9 the full Council. In each case, the THE cause of removal shall be stated in writing
- 10 and a public hearing held on the removal. [However, in Prince George's County the
- 11 Commission member sought to be removed may waive in writing the public hearing
- 12 held by the Council. Further, this provision does not apply to any Prince George's
- 13 member of the Commission in office on June 1, 1975 for the member's current term of
- 14 office.] Any vacancy occurring in the membership of the Commission from
- 15 Montgomery County for any cause shall be filled by the County Council for the
- 16 unexpired term [and any vacancy occurring in the membership of the Commission
- 17 from Prince George's County shall be filled in the manner provided in this title for the
- 18 making of appointments to the Commission. A person appointed to fill any vacancy for
- 19 an unexpired term shall be BY a member of the same political party as was
- 20 represented by the member who vacated the office.
- 21 (B) THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY MAY REMOVE AT
- 22 WILL ANY MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION APPOINTED FROM PRINCE GEORGE'S
