- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (a) The driver of each vehicle involved in an accident that results in bodily
- 18 injury to or death of another person immediately shall stop the vehicle as close as
- 19 possible to AND WITHIN VIEW OF the scene of the accident, without obstructing traffic
- 20 more than necessary.
- 21 (b) The driver of each vehicle involved in an accident that results in bodily
- 22 injury to or death of another person immediately shall return to and remain at the
- 23 scene of the accident until the driver has complied with § 20-104 of this title.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 October 1, 2003.
