A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Education - Public Schools - Health and Safety of Students

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain county boards of education to adequately repair,
- 4 improve, and maintain each public school in the county; establishing certain
- 5 requirements for determining whether a public school is adequately repaired,
- 6 improved, and maintained; requiring the State Department of Education to
- 7 order a county board of education to repair, improve, or maintain a public school
- 8 under certain circumstances and within a certain period of time; requiring the
- 9 Department to issue a second notice to a county board to repair, improve, or
- maintain a public school under certain circumstances; requiring the Department
- 11 to close a public school under certain circumstances; authorizing the
- Department to grant a certain extension for a county board to repair, improve, or
- maintain a public school under certain circumstances; and generally relating to
- public schools and the health and safety of students.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 22 Article Education
- 23 7-420.
- 24 (A) A COUNTY BOARD SHALL ADEQUATELY REPAIR, IMPROVE, AND MAINTAIN
- 25 EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY.
- 26 (B) A PUBLIC SCHOOL IS ADEQUATELY REPAIRED, IMPROVED, AND
- 27 MAINTAINED UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL IS FREE FROM:

- HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS ARISING FROM DEFECTIVE OR (1) 2 IMPROPERLY UTILIZED OR INSTALLED ELECTRICAL WIRING, EQUIPMENT, OR
- 3 APPLIANCES:
- CONDITIONS THAT INTERFERE WITH THE PROPER OPERATION OF (2)
- 5 THE PLUMBING SYSTEM INCLUDING FAUCETS, DRINKING FOUNTAINS, AND
- 6 SHOWERS;
- HAZARDOUS LEVELS OF ASBESTOS OR ASBESTOS-CONTAINING (3) 8 MATERIALS:
- HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS ARISING FROM DEFECTIVE HEATING AND (4) 10 COOLING SYSTEMS:
- 11 (5) CONDITIONS LIABLE TO CAUSE OR CONTRIBUTE TO THE SPREAD OF 12 FIRE;
- 13 CONDITIONS THAT INTERFERE WITH THE EFFICIENCY OR 14 OPERATION OF ANY FIRE PROTECTION EQUIPMENT AND SYSTEM; AND
- OBSTRUCTIONS TO OR ON FIRE ESCAPES, STAIRS, PASSAGEWAYS, 15
- 16 DOORS, OR WINDOWS THAT ARE LIABLE TO INTERFERE WITH THE EGRESS OF
- 17 OCCUPANTS OR THE OPERATION OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT IN CASE OF FIRE.
- IF A COUNTY BOARD FAILS TO REPAIR, IMPROVE, AND MAINTAIN A 18 (C) (1)
- 19 PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
- 20 SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ORDER THE COUNTY BOARD TO PERFORM THE
- 21 REQUIRED REPAIR, IMPROVEMENT, OR MAINTENANCE WITHIN 30 DAYS.
- IF THE COUNTY BOARD DOES NOT PERFORM THE REQUIRED REPAIR, 22 (2)
- 23 IMPROVEMENT, OR MAINTENANCE, AND THE COUNTY BOARD HAS NOT OBTAINED A
- 24 TIME EXTENSION UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT
- 25 SHALL ISSUE A SECOND ORDER TO THE COUNTY BOARD TO PERFORM THE REQUIRED
- 26 REPAIR, IMPROVEMENT, OR MAINTENANCE WITHIN 15 DAYS OF THE SECOND ORDER.
- 27 IF AFTER THE DEPARTMENT ISSUES A SECOND ORDER TO THE
- 28 COUNTY BOARD AND THE COUNTY BOARD FAILS TO PERFORM THE REQUIRED
- 29 REPAIR, IMPROVEMENT, OR MAINTENANCE WITHIN 15 DAYS OF THE SECOND ORDER,
- 30 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ORDER THE COUNTY BOARD TO CLOSE THE PUBLIC
- 31 SCHOOL UNTIL THE REQUIRED REPAIR, IMPROVEMENT, OR MAINTENANCE IS
- 32 COMPLETE.
- AFTER THE DEPARTMENT ISSUES AN ORDER UNDER THIS SECTION 33 (D)
- 34 AND BEFORE THE DEPARTMENT ISSUES A SECOND ORDER UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 35 THE COUNTY BOARD MAY REQUEST A TIME EXTENSION TO PERFORM THE REPAIR,
- 36 IMPROVEMENT, OR MAINTENANCE IF THE COUNTY BOARD IS UNABLE TO PROMPTLY
- 37 CONDUCT THE REPAIR, IMPROVEMENT, OR MAINTENANCE BECAUSE OF THE NATURE
- 38 OF THE WORK REQUIRED.

- 1 (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY EXTEND THE TIME IN WHICH THE COUNTY
- 2 BOARD IS REQUIRED TO PERFORM THE REPAIR, IMPROVEMENT, OR MAINTENANCE
- 3 UNTIL THE COMPLETION DATE ON A WRITTEN ESTIMATE FROM THE CONTRACTOR
- 4 WHO WILL PERFORM THE REPAIR, IMPROVEMENT, OR MAINTENANCE.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 2003.
