14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Agriculture

17 2-504.1.

18 (a) In each county containing productive agricultural land, the county

19 governing body shall appoint an agricultural preservation advisory board.

20 (b) (1) [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS

21 SUBSECTION, THE agricultural preservation advisory board shall consist of five

1 members, at least three of whom shall be owner-operators of commercial farms who 2 earn 50 percent or more of their income from farming.

3 (2) IN WORCESTER COUNTY, THE AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION
4 ADVISORY BOARD SHALL CONSIST OF SEVEN MEMBERS, AT LEAST FOUR OF WHOM
5 SHALL BE OWNER-OPERATORS OF COMMERCIAL FARMS WHO EARN 50 PERCENT OR
6 MORE OF THEIR INCOME FROM FARMING.

7 (c) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, each member 8 of an agricultural preservation advisory board shall be appointed for a term of office 9 of five years.

10 (2) In Charles County AND IN WORCESTER COUNTY, a member shall 11 serve a term of office of 4 years.

12 (3) No member shall serve for more than two consecutive full terms.

13 (4) Appointment to fill a vacancy shall be for the remainder of the 14 unexpired term.

15 (d) Duties of each agricultural preservation advisory board shall be:

16 (1) To advise the county governing body with respect to the 17 establishment of agricultural districts and the approval of purchases of easements by 18 the Foundation within the county;

19 (2) To assist the county governing body in reviewing the status of 20 agricultural districts and land under easement;

21 (3) To advise the Foundation concerning county priorities for 22 agricultural preservation;

23 (4) To approve or disapprove an application by the county for24 certification under § 5-408 of the State Finance and Procurement Article;

25 (5) To promote preservation of agriculture within the county by offering 26 information and assistance to farmers with respect to establishment of districts and 27 purchase of easements; and

28 (6) To perform any other duties as assigned by the county governing29 body.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms altered by this 31 Act shall only affect members appointed after October 1, 2003, and members serving 32 on October 1, 2003, shall serve their original terms.

33 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect34 October 1, 2003.
