1 AN ACT concerning

2 Natural Resources - Hunting Wild Waterfowl - Susquehanna Flats

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering certain distances that a person must be from shore when
- 4 hunting wild waterfowl in the Susquehanna Flats while the person is standing
- 5 in water on the natural bottom, in a boat that is drifting or being sculled, or in
- a boat that is anchored; and generally relating to hunting wild waterfowl in the
- 7 Susquehanna Flats.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (a) A person may hunt wild waterfowl while standing in water on the natural
- 18 bottom only in the waters of the Susquehanna Flats, the nontidal waters of the
- 19 Potomac River, and in other waters of the State in areas and on days the Department
- 20 prescribes by regulation.
- 21 (b) A person may hunt wild waterfowl while standing in water on the natural
- 22 bottom at a licensed offshore stationary blind or blind site.
- 23 (c) A person hunting wild waterfowl while standing in water on the natural
- 24 bottom shall remain at least 250 yards from all offshore stationary blinds or blind
- 25 sites or another person hunting wild waterfowl offshore.
- 26 (d) (1) A person hunting wild waterfowl while standing in water on the
- 27 natural bottom shall be at least 800 yards from shore including shore emerging at

- 1 mean low water except in nontidal waters of the Potomac River, IN THE WATERS OF
- 2 THE SUSQUEHANNA FLATS, or while hunting at a licensed stationary blind or blind
- 3 site.
- 4 (2) IN THE WATERS OF THE SUSQUEHANNA FLATS, A PERSON HUNTING
- 5 WILD WATERFOWL WHILE STANDING IN WATER ON THE NATURAL BOTTOM SHALL
- 6 BE AT LEAST 400 YARDS FROM SHORE INCLUDING SHORE EMERGING AT MEAN LOW
- 7 WATER.
- 8 (e) A person may not hunt wild waterfowl while standing in State waters on
- 9 the natural bottom when the natural bottom is privately owned, unless the hunter
- 10 has the written permission of the landowner.
- 11 (f) Except at a licensed stationary blind or blind site, a nonresident may not
- 12 hunt wild waterfowl while standing in water on the natural bottom unless
- 13 accompanied by a Maryland resident.

- 15 (a) A person may hunt wild waterfowl from a boat that is drifting or being
- 16 sculled, only in:
- 17 (1) The nontidal waters of the Potomac River, Conococheague Creek, and
- 18 the Monocacy River;
- 19 (2) The Susquehanna Flats, Elk River, and that portion of the Sassafras
- 20 River in Cecil County located west of 75 degrees 58 minutes 45 seconds;
- 21 (3) Chincoteague Bay, Sinepuxent Bay, Isle of Wight, Assawoman Bay,
- 22 and their respective tributaries in Worcester County; or
- 23 (4) Zones prescribed by the Department by regulation.
- 24 (b) While hunting wild waterfowl from a boat that is drifting or being sculled,
- 25 a person shall remain at least 250 yards from all offshore stationary blinds or blind
- 26 sites or another person hunting wild waterfowl offshore.
- 27 (c) A person hunting wild waterfowl from a boat that is drifting or being
- 28 sculled shall be at least 800 yards from shore including shore emerging at mean low
- 29 water except in the nontidal waters of the Potomac River, IN THE WATERS OF THE
- 30 SUSQUEHANNA FLATS, in Conococheague Creek, and in the Monocacy River.
- 31 (2) IN THE WATERS OF THE SUSQUEHANNA FLATS, A PERSON HUNTING
- 32 WILD WATERFOWL FROM A BOAT THAT IS DRIFTING OR BEING SCULLED SHALL BE
- 33 AT LEAST 400 YARDS FROM SHORE INCLUDING SHORE EMERGING AT MEAN LOW
- 34 WATER.
- 35 (d) A nonresident may not hunt wild waterfowl from a boat that is drifting or
- 36 being sculled unless accompanied by a Maryland resident.

- 2 (a) A person may hunt wild waterfowl from a boat that is anchored only in:
- 3 (1) The nontidal waters of the Potomac River;
- 4 (2) The waters of the Susquehanna Flats, Elk River, and that portion of
- 5 the Sassafras River in Cecil County located west of 75 degrees 58 minutes 45 seconds;
- 6 (3) The waters of Chincoteague Bay, Sinepuxent Bay, Isle of Wight,
- 7 Assawoman Bay, and their respective tributaries in Worcester County; or
- 8 (4) Zones prescribed by the Department by regulation.
- 9 (b) A person may hunt wild waterfowl from a boat that is anchored at a
- 10 licensed offshore stationary blind or blind site.
- 11 (c) A person hunting wild waterfowl from a boat that is anchored shall remain
- 12 250 yards from all offshore stationary blinds or blind sites or another person hunting
- 13 wild waterfowl offshore.
- 14 (d) (1) A person hunting wild waterfowl from a boat that is anchored shall
- 15 be at least 800 yards from shore including shore emerging at mean low water except
- 16 in nontidal waters of the Potomac River, IN THE WATERS OF THE SUSQUEHANNA
- 17 FLATS, or unless anchored at a licensed offshore stationary blind or blind site.
- 18 (2) IN THE WATERS OF THE SUSQUEHANNA FLATS, A PERSON HUNTING
- 19 WILD WATERFOWL FROM A BOAT THAT IS ANCHORED SHALL BE AT LEAST 400 YARDS
- 20 FROM SHORE INCLUDING SHORE EMERGING AT MEAN LOW WATER.
- 21 (e) Except at a licensed stationary blind or blind site, a nonresident may not
- 22 hunt wild waterfowl from a boat that is anchored unless accompanied by a Maryland
- 23 resident.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 25 effect October 1, 2003.
