- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages 2 12-302. 3 (b) (4) (i) The provisions of this paragraph apply only in Carroll County. 4 (iii) A person 18 years old [and] OR older may serve, [and] sell, OR 5 DELIVER alcoholic beverages in restaurants [in connection with the serving and 6 selling of a meal].

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2003.
