## 2 Baltimore County - Sheriff's Office - Under-Sheriff

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Sheriff of Baltimore County to appoint an
- 4 under-sheriff who shall serve at the pleasure of the Sheriff; providing that
- 5 certain provisions of the county merit system and the rules and regulations
- 6 passed by the Baltimore County Council do not apply to the under-sheriff; and
- 7 generally relating to the appointment of an under-sheriff in the Baltimore
- 8 County Sheriff's Office.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 16 Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

17 2-309.

- 18 (e) The Sheriff of Baltimore County shall receive a salary of not more than
- 19 \$70,000. The Sheriff shall appoint an under-sheriff [and] WHO SHALL SERVE AT THE
- 20 PLEASURE OF THE SHERIFF. THE SHERIFF SHALL ALSO APPOINT any number of
- 21 deputies and any clerical assistant required by the duties of the office. The Sheriff
- 22 may also appoint a number of deputies to the ranks of chief deputy, captain,
- 23 lieutenant, and sergeant as his duties and responsibilities require. The cost and
- 24 expense of these supervisory, administrative, and clerical positions, including
- 25 salaries, shall be as provided in the budget of the county by the County Executive and
- 26 as approved by the County Council. [All] EXCEPT FOR THE UNDER-SHERIFF, ALL
- 27 full-time employees under this subsection are subject to the provisions of the county
- 28 merit system and the rules and regulations passed by the County Council pursuant to
- 29 the charter, as to qualifications, compensation, and other regulations. Part-time 30 deputies may not be employed by the Sheriff's office. However, the Sheriff may

- 1 appoint as part-time deputies persons employed in specific plants, institutions,2 colleges, and hospitals situated within Baltimore County who are limited to service
- 3 only within the particular facility where they are employed, and who may not be
- 4 compensated by Baltimore County for their services.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 2003.
