- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) (1) The County Commissioners may lease, sell, at either public or private
- 19 sale, and convey or otherwise dispose of and convey any interest in real estate held by
- 20 the County Commissioners and no longer needed for public use.
- 21 (2) The COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' intent to sell, dispose of, or convey,
- 22 except in the case of a conveyance made between the county and any federal, state or
- 23 local government, shall be advertised in a newspaper of general distribution in the
- 24 county, once a week for 3 successive weeks.
- 25 (3) (I) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL ADVERTISE THEIR
- 26 INTENT TO LEASE REAL PROPERTY TO ANOTHER PERSON OR ENTITY IF THE
- 27 MONTHLY RENT FOR THE REAL PROPERTY IS GREATER THAN \$2,000.
