1 (2) If the Program recipient is absent from a nursing facility due to 2 hospitalization for an acute condition, the facility shall receive payment for each day 3 that the Program recipient is hospitalized and a bed is reserved and made available 4 for the return of that Program recipient. 5 If a Program recipient is on leave of absence from a nursing facility, 6 the facility shall receive payment for each day that the Program recipient is absent 7 and a bed is reserved and made available for the return of that Program recipient. Payments under subsection (b)(2) of this section may not be made for 8 (1)(c) 9 more than 15 days for any single hospital stay. 10 (2) (i) Payments under subsection (b)(3) of this section may not be 11 made for more than 18 days in any calendar year. (ii) Notwithstanding any rule or regulation, a leave of absence is 13 not subject to any requirement that it may not exceed a particular number of days a 14 visit, except that the leave of absence may not exceed a total of 18 days during any 15 [12-month period] CALENDAR YEAR. 16 (d) Payments required under this section: 17 [shall] SHALL be made according to the per diem payment (1) 18 procedures that the Department sets [and may not be less than the per diem payments made to the nursing facility for days when the Program recipient is present 20 in the facility]; AND MAY NOT INCLUDE PAYMENT FOR NURSING SERVICES. 21 (2) 22 A nursing facility may not make additional charges against a Program 23 recipient because the Program recipient is absent temporarily from the nursing 24 facility. 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be 26 construed to apply retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect payments made by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to a nursing 28 facility for a reserved bed on or after July 1, 2002. 29 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 30 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, 31 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members 32 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from 33 the date it is enacted.
