- 9 (2) In Baltimore City, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine, or

- 13 (3) In Baltimore County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine,
- 14 or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued, except by way of renewal, to a

- 17 (4) IN WASHINGTON COUNTY, A CLASS A OR CLASS D BEER, BEER AND
