- 18 (b-3) (1) In Anne Arundel County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light
- 19 wine, or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued except by way of renewal to
- 20 a person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverage
- 21 license in any other state, or Washington, D.C.
- 22 (2) In Baltimore City, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine, or
- 23 beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued except by way of renewal to a person,
- 24 corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverage license in any
- 25 other state.
- 26 (3) In Baltimore County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine,
- 27 or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued, except by way of renewal, to a

- 1 person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverages
- 2 license in any other state or in Washington, D.C.
- 3 (4) IN WASHINGTON COUNTY, A CLASS A OR CLASS D BEER, BEER AND
- 4 LIGHT WINE, OR BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED, EXCEPT BY
- 5 WAY OF RENEWAL, TO A PERSON, CORPORATION, OR LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY
- 6 HOLDING AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE IN ANY OTHER STATE OR IN
- 7 WASHINGTON, D.C.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
