4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting in Washington County certain alcoholic beverages 5 licenses from being issued, except by renewal, to persons, corporations, or 6 limited liability companies that hold an alcoholic beverages license in any other 7 state or Washington, D.C.; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses 8 in Washington County.
9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 10 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages 11 Section 9-102(b-3) 12 Annotated Code of Maryland 13 (2001 Replacement Volume and 2002 Supplement)
14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (b-3) (1) In Anne Arundel County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light 19 wine, or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued except by way of renewal to 20 a person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverage 21 license in any other state, or Washington, D.C.

- 1 (2) In Baltimore City, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine, or
- 2 beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued except by way of renewal to a person,
- 3 corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverage license in any
- 4 other state.
- 5 (3) In Baltimore County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine,
- 6 or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued, except by way of renewal, to a
- 7 person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverages
- 8 license in any other state or in Washington, D.C.
- 9 (4) IN WASHINGTON COUNTY, A CLASS A OR CLASS D BEER, BEER AND
- 10 LIGHT WINE, OR BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED, EXCEPT BY
- 11 WAY OF RENEWAL, TO A PERSON, CORPORATION, OR LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY
- 12 HOLDING AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE IN ANY OTHER STATE OR IN
- 13 WASHINGTON, D.C.
- 14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 15 October 1, 2003.
