- 19 (A) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY PROVIDED BY LAW, A PERSON WHO
- 20 IS CONVICTED OF FAILING TO YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO ANOTHER VEHICLE
- 21 UNDER TITLE 21, SUBTITLE 4 OF THIS ARTICLE IS SUBJECT TO:
- 22 (1) IF THE VIOLATION CONTRIBUTES TO AN ACCIDENT RESULTING IN
- 23 BODILY INJURY TO ANOTHER PERSON:
- 24 (I) A FINE OF \$500; AND
- 25 (II) SUSPENSION OF THE PERSON'S LICENSE FOR 90 DAYS; AND
