5	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

8	(a) A circuit court or the District Court may:
9	(1) impose a sentence for a specified time and provide that a lesser time be served in confinement;
21	(2) suspend the remainder of the sentence; and
22	(3) EXCEPT FOR CRIMES UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, order probation for a time longer than the sentence but not longer than:
24	(i) 5 years if the probation is ordered by a circuit court; or
25	(ii) 3 years if the probation is ordered by the District Court.
