- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 22
- 23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

24 **Article - Criminal Law**

25 SUBTITLE 4. VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINALS.

26 12-401.

- 27 IN THIS SUBTITLE, "VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINAL" MEANS AN ELECTRONIC (A)
- 28 CONTRIVANCE, MACHINE, OR OTHER DEVICE THAT, BY THE INSERTION OF AN
- 29 OBJECT SUCH AS A COIN OR TOKEN OR ON PAYMENT OF OTHER CONSIDERATION,

- 1 ENTITLES THE PLAYER WHO OPERATES THE DEVICE, WHETHER BY SKILL OR 2 CHANCE, TO RECEIVE:
- 3 (1) TOKENS; OR
- 4 (2) ANYTHING OF VALUE, INCLUDING CASH, PREMIUMS, AND
- 5 MERCHANDISE.
- 6~ (B) THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT APPLY TO SLOT MACHINES ALLOWED UNDER \$\$ 7 12-304 THROUGH 12-306 OF THIS TITLE.
- 8 (C) (1) BEFORE AN OWNER OF A VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY MAY OFFER
- 9 VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINALS FOR PUBLIC USE, THE OWNER SHALL REQUEST THE
- 10 GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY IS TO
- 11 BE LOCATED TO HOLD A SPECIAL ELECTION.
- 12 (2) THE COST OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION IS TO BE PAID BY THE COUNTY.
- 13 (3) THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS OF THE COUNTY AND
- 14 THE COUNTY GOVERNING BODY SHALL DO THOSE THINGS NECESSARY AND PROPER
- 15 TO PROVIDE FOR AND HOLD THE SPECIAL ELECTION.
- 16 (4) THE COUNTY GOVERNING BODY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO 17 CARRY OUT THIS SUBSECTION.
- 18 (D) (1) THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND THE COUNTY GOVERNING BODY
- 19 SHALL PLACE ON THE BALLOT AT THE SPECIAL ELECTION THE TITLE
- 20 "ESTABLISHMENT AND LOCATION OF VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY IN THE COUNTY"
- 21 AND UNDERNEATH THE TITLE, ON SEPARATE LINES, OPTIONS FOR THE VOTER TO
- 22 SELECT "FOR THE VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY" OR "AGAINST THE VIDEO LOTTERY
- 23 FACILITY".
- 24 (2) BEFORE THE SPECIAL ELECTION, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
- 25 ELECTIONS OF THE COUNTY SHALL PUBLISH IN AT LEAST TWO NEWSPAPERS OF
- 26 GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE COUNTY, AT LEAST ONCE A WEEK FOR 3
- 27 CONSECUTIVE WEEKS, NOTICE OF THE REFERENDUM AND A COPY OF THE
- 28 RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE COUNTY GOVERNING BODY.
- 29 (E) IF THE MAJORITY OF THE VOTERS VOTING ON THE RESOLUTION VOTE
- 30 FOR THE VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY, THE OWNER OF THE VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY
- 31 SHALL BE CONSIDERED ELIGIBLE TO BE GRANTED PERMISSION TO OFFER VIDEO
- 32 LOTTERY TERMINALS FOR PUBLIC USE IN THAT COUNTY.
- 33 (F) IF THE MAJORITY OF THE VOTERS VOTE AGAINST THE VIDEO LOTTERY
- 34 FACILITY, THEN THE OWNER OF THE VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY MAY NOT BE
- 35 GRANTED PERMISSION TO OFFER A VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINAL FOR PUBLIC USE IN
- 36 THAT COUNTY.

- 1 THE ELECTION REQUIREMENT UNDER THIS SECTION IS IN ADDITION TO (G)
- 2 AND DOES NOT SUPPLANT ANY OTHER REQUIREMENT UNDER LAW THAT A PERSON 3 WHO SEEKS TO OFFER VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINALS FOR PUBLIC USE MUST MEET.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 5 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
- 6 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
- 7 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 8 the date it is enacted.
