- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to negotiate a revenue sharing
- 4 arrangement with neighboring states that have gaming facilities with video
- 5 lottery terminals, based in part on the number of State visitors to those gaming
- 6 facilities; providing that revenue raised by the arrangement should be paid into
- 7 the General Fund; allowing the General Assembly to authorize the installation
- 8 of an ample number of video lottery terminals only at certain locations in the
- 9 State under certain conditions; specifying that the State will not install video
- lottery terminals near the border of a state when an arrangement with the state
- is in effect; providing that this Act does not apply to certain slot machines;
- defining a certain term; and generally relating to interstate revenue sharing.

19 Preamble

- WHEREAS, The tourist and entertainment industries of Maryland are critical
- 21 components of the State's economic structure and, properly managed, can contribute
- 22 substantively to the State's prosperity; and
- 23 WHEREAS, The General Assembly finds that Maryland residents are taking
- 24 millions of dollars of disposable income out of the State to play video lottery terminals
- 25 in neighboring states; and
- 26 WHEREAS, The General Assembly finds that the attraction of video lottery
- 27 terminals in neighboring states has resulted in increased economic activity in those
- 28 states; now, therefore,

- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 3 Article Criminal Law
- 4 SUBTITLE 4. VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINALS.
- 5 12-401.
- 6 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE, "VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINAL" MEANS AN ELECTRONIC
- 7 CONTRIVANCE, MACHINE, OR OTHER DEVICE THAT, BY THE INSERTION OF AN
- 8 OBJECT SUCH AS A COIN OR TOKEN OR ON PAYMENT OF CONSIDERATION, ENTITLES
- 9 THE PLAYER WHO OPERATES THE DEVICE, WHETHER BY SKILL OR CHANCE, TO
- 10 RECEIVE:
- 11 (1) TOKENS; OR
- 12 (2) ANYTHING OF VALUE, INCLUDING CASH, PREMIUMS, AND
- 13 MERCHANDISE.
- 14 (B) THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT APPLY TO SLOT MACHINES COVERED UNDER §§
- 15 12-304 THROUGH 12-306 OF THIS TITLE.
- 16 (C) THE GOVERNOR SHALL NEGOTIATE A REVENUE SHARING ARRANGEMENT
- 17 WITH EACH NEIGHBORING STATE WITH GAMING FACILITIES THAT FEATURE VIDEO
- 18 LOTTERY TERMINALS, BASED IN PART ON THE NUMBER OF STATE VISITORS TO
- 19 THOSE GAMING FACILITIES.
- 20 (D) REVENUE REALIZED BY A REVENUE SHARING ARRANGEMENT WITH A
- 21 NEIGHBORING STATE SHALL BE PAID INTO THE GENERAL FUND.
- 22 (E) IF THE GOVERNING BODY OF A NEIGHBORING STATE DOES NOT COMMIT
- 23 TO THE NEGOTIATED REVENUE SHARING ARRANGEMENT, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY
- 24 MAY AUTHORIZE THE INSTALLATION OF AN AMPLE NUMBER OF VIDEO LOTTERY
- 25 TERMINALS ONLY AT:
- 26 (1) THE CHESAPEAKE HOUSE ON ROUTE I-95 OR A NEARBY VENUE
- 27 CLOSE TO THE DELAWARE STATE LINE;
- 28 (2) A VENUE THAT IS IN HAGERSTOWN OR THAT IS CLOSE TO THE
- 29 INTERSECTION OF ROUTES I-70 AND I-81 OR TO THE VIRGINIA, PENNSYLVANIA, AND
- 30 WEST VIRGINIA STATE LINES; OR
- 31 (3) SANDY HOOK OR A NEARBY VENUE CLOSE TO THE WEST VIRGINIA
- 32 STATE LINE.
- 33 (F) VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINALS MAY NOT BE INSTALLED NEAR THE BORDER
- 34 OF A NEIGHBORING STATE WHEN A REVENUE SHARING ARRANGEMENT WITH THAT
- 35 STATE IS IN EFFECT.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2003.
