A BILL ENTITLED

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- 2 Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Rollingcrest-Chillum 3 **Community Center**
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- 5 \$500,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Rollingcrest/Chillum
- Recreation Council and the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning 6
- 7 Commission for certain development or improvement purposes; providing for
- 8 disbursement of the loan proceeds; and providing generally for the issuance and
- sale of bonds evidencing the loan. 9
- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10
- 11 MARYLAND, That:
- 12 The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on (1)
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince
- 14 George's County Rollingcrest-Chillum Community Center Loan of 2003 in the total
- 15 principal amount of \$500,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and
- 16 delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of
- 17 Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through
- 18 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 19 The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 20 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 21 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 22 The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 23 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 24 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 25 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 26 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 27 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Rollingcrest/Chillum Recreation
- 28 Council and the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission for the
- 29 planning, design, and construction of an addition to the Rollingcrest-Chillum
- 30 Community Center, located in Chillum.

- 1 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 2 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 3 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years

- 4 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 June 1, 2003.
