13 14 15	WHEREAS, Chapter 732 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1994 authorized the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to establish, by ordinance, community benefits district management authorities, including the Charles Village Community Benefits District, <i>Management Authority</i> , to provide certain services to the business interests and residents of the Charles Village Community property owners, residents, and business owners within the District's boundaries; and
19 20 21 22	WHEREAS, Chapter 732 of the Acts of 1994, by adding to the Baltimore City Charter Article II - General Powers, Section 63(63)(g), required the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to review the effectiveness and desirability of continuing the existence of the District any community benefits district created under the Act every 4 years from the enactment of the ordinance and provided that the Act take effect June 1, 1994, and terminate at the end of May 31, 1997, with no further action required by the General Assembly; and
	WHEREAS, The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore did establish the Charles Village Community Benefits District, <i>Management</i> Authority by Ordinance No. 414 (Council Bill No. 891), effective July 1, 1994; and
29 30 31 32 33	WHEREAS, Chapter 655 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1997 required amended Chapter 732 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1994, by adding to the Baltimore City Charter Article II - General Powers, Section (63)(h), to require the General Assembly to review and determine the desirability of continuing the existence, or allowing the expiration of each community benefit district, including the Charles Village Community Benefits District, Management Authority, every 4 years beginning with the regular legislative session of 2000, and extended the termination date of Chapter 732 of the Acts of 1994 until the end of May 31, 2000; and
37 38	WHEREAS, Pursuant to the power contained in Baltimore City Charter Article II - General Powers, Section (63)(g), the Mayor and City Council did renew and continue the Charles Village Community Benefits District, Management Authority for 4 additional years by Resolution No. 98-10 (Council Bill 97-589), effective July 1, 1998; and

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- WHEREAS, Chapter 89 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2000 amended
- 2 the provision requiring the General Assembly to review and determine the
- 3 desirability of continuing the existence, or allowing the expiration of the Charles
- 4 Village Community Benefits District, Management Authority to require the Mayor
- 5 and City Council to review and determine the desirability of continuing the existence,
- 6 or allowing the expiration of the Charles Village Community Benefits District,
- 7 <u>Management Authority</u> every 4 years beginning with the first meeting of the Mayor
- 8 and City Council in December 2002; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Pursuant to the power contained in Baltimore City Charter Article
- 10 H General Powers, Section 63(g), the Mayor and City Council did renew and
- 11 continue the Charles Village Community Benefits District Management Authority for
- 12 4 additional years by Resolution No. 98 10 (Council Bill 97 589), effective July 1,
- 13 1998; and
- WHEREAS, Chapter 89 of the Acts of 2000 repealed the termination date of
- 15 Chapter 732 of the Acts of 1994, as amended by Chapter 655 of the Acts of 1997,
- 16 thereby effectively continuing the authority for the *Charles Village Community*
- 17 Benefits District, Management Authority since 1994; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The Office of Counsel to the General Assembly concluded in a letter
- 19 of advice to Delegate McIntosh dated February 3, 2003, that the Charles Village
- 20 Community Benefits District has been in continuous effect since June 1, 1994; now,
- 21 therefore,
- WHEREAS, In passing Chapter 89 of the Acts of 2000, the General Assembly
- 23 intended the Charles Village Community Benefits District, Management Authority to
- 24 continue in existence until June 30, 2002 unless renewed and continued for 4
- 25 additional years by the Mayor and City Council, but the General Assembly did not
- 26 intend to interrupt the 4-year 4-year review cycle under Baltimore City Charter
- 27 Article II General Powers, Section (63)(g) that had existed since 1994; and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to the power still contained in Baltimore City Charter
- 29 Article II General Powers, Section 63(63)(g), the Mayor and City Council did renew
- 30 and continue the Charles Village Community Benefits District, Management
- 31 Authority effective July 1, 2002 by Resolution No. 02-28 (Council Bill 02-0760); but,
- 32 because of the conflict between Section 63(63)(g) and Chapter 89's the revision by
- 33 Chapter 89 of the Acts of 2000 to Section 63(63)(h)(1)(i), the Mayor and City Council
- 34 renewed and continued the Charles Village Community Benefits District,
- 35 Management Authority for only 1 year; and
- 36 WHEREAS, The Attorney General's office advised in a letter of February 27,
- 37 2003, that at no time has there been a lapse or hiatus in the authority conferred by
- 38 State law on the Mayor and City Council to continue the existence of community
- 39 benefits districts, including the Charles Village Community Benefits District,
- 40 Management Authority; and
- 41 WHEREAS, The Mayor and City Council have lawfully exercised the authority
- 42 conferred by State law to continue the existence of community benefits districts or to

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	allow them to expire, including the Charles Village Community Benefits District,  Management Authority; and
5 6 7	WHEREAS, The General Assembly wishes to retroactively clarify the authority conferred on the Mayor and City Council to continue community benefits districts or to allow them to expire, including the Charles Village Community Benefits District, Management Authority, and to ratify and confirm the acts of the Mayor and City Council in continuing the existence of such districts, including the Charles Village Community Benefits District, Management Authority; now, therefore,
9 10	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 16 17	The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall have full power and authority to exercise all of the powers heretofore or hereafter granted to it by the Constitution of Maryland or by any Public General or Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland; and in particular, without limitation upon the foregoing, shall have power by ordinance, or such other method as may be provided for in its Charter, subject to the provisions of said Constitution and Public General Laws:

	(h) (1) The Mayor and City Council shall review and determine the desirability of continuing the existence of each community benefits district established under this section every 4 years:

28 29 30 31	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly of Maryland that this Act affirms that the Charles Village Community Benefits District, <i>Management Authority</i> has been in continuous effect since 1994 and will remain in effect unless the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore expressly terminate the continuing existence of the <i>Benefits</i> District <i>or allow the Benefits District to expire</i> .
33 34	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2003.
37 38	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all acts of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore relating prior to January 1, 2003 that relate to the continued and continuous existence of community benefits districts and authorities, including the Charles Village Community Benefits District, Management Authority, are hereby ratified and confirmed.

## 1 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, This That this Act:

- 2 <u>(1)</u> shall be construed to apply retroactively and shall be applied to and
- 3 interpreted to affect the authority conferred on the Mayor and City Council to
- 4 continue community benefits districts or to allow them to expire, including the
- 5 Charles Village Community Benefits District, Management Authority on or after
- 6 December 1, 2001; and
- 7 (2) may not be construed to impact the 4-year review required under
- 8 Baltimore City Charter Article II General Powers, Section (63)(g).
- 9 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 10 June 1, 2003.
