- 4 FOR the purpose of declaring that the intent of the General Assembly is to affirm that
- 5 the Charles Village Community Benefits District has been in continuous effect
- 6 since a certain year and will remain in effect unless the Mayor and City Council
- of Baltimore expressly terminate the continuing existence of the District; and
- 8 generally relating to the Charles Village Community Benefits District.

9 Preamble

- WHEREAS, Chapter 732 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1994 authorized
- 11 the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to establish, by ordinance, community
- 12 benefits district management authorities, including the Charles Village Community
- 13 Benefits District, to provide certain services to the business interests and residents of
- 14 the Charles Village Community; and
- WHEREAS, Chapter 732 of the Acts of 1994 required the Mayor and City
- 16 Council of Baltimore to review the effectiveness and desirability of continuing the
- 17 existence of the District every 4 years from the enactment of the ordinance and
- 18 provided that the Act take effect June 1, 1994, and terminate at the end of May 31,
- 19 1997, with no further action required by the General Assembly; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Chapter 655 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1997 required
- 21 the General Assembly to review and determine the desirability of continuing the
- 22 existence of each community benefit district, including the Charles Village
- 23 Community Benefits District, every 4 years beginning with the regular legislative
- 24 session of 2000 and extended the termination date of Chapter 732 of the Acts of 1994
- 25 until the end of May 31, 2000; and
- WHEREAS, Chapter 89 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2000 amended
- 27 the provision requiring the General Assembly to review and determine the
- 28 desirability of continuing the existence of the Charles Village Community Benefits
- 29 District to require the Mayor and City Council to review and determine the
- 30 desirability of continuing the existence of the Charles Village Community Benefits

- 1 District every 4 years beginning with the first meeting of the Mayor and City Council
- 2 in December 2002; and
- WHEREAS, Chapter 89 of the Acts of 2000 repealed the termination date of
- 4 Chapter 732 of the Acts of 1994, as amended by Chapter 655 of the Acts of 1997,
- 5 thereby effectively continuing the authority for the District since 1994; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Office of Counsel to the General Assembly concluded in a letter
- 7 of advice to Delegate McIntosh dated February 3, 2003, that the Charles Village
- 8 Community Benefits District has been in continuous effect since June 1, 1994; now,
- 9 therefore,
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That it is the intent of the General Assembly of Maryland that this Act
- 12 affirms that the Charles Village Community Benefits District has been in continuous
- 13 effect since 1994 and will remain in effect unless the Mayor and City Council of
- 14 Baltimore expressly terminate the continuing existence of the District.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 2003.
