1 2	(1) To make loans to nonprofit organizations, local jurisdictions, business ntities, and individuals for the purpose of:
3 4	(i) Acquiring, rehabilitating, [or] restoring, OR REFINANCING istoric properties; or
7 8 9	(ii) Short-term financing for costs directly related to work required recommended by the Trust or the State Historic Preservation Officer to be indertaken before proceeding with or continuing a construction project in the State eing funded with federal or State moneys, which may include the costs of studies, surveys, plans and specifications, and architectural, engineering, or other special ervices;
11 12	(2) To cover administrative costs directly related to the MHT Loan Program;
15	(3) To fund the purchase or acquisition by the Trust of historic properties or partial interests in historic properties for use in accordance with the Trust's authorized purposes or for resale or lease subject to appropriate preservation covenants; and
19 20	(4) To fund the costs of restoration or rehabilitation of historic properties owned by the Trust for use in accordance with the Trust's authorized purposes or for esale or lease subject to appropriate preservation covenants, which may include costs lirectly related to restoration or rehabilitation such as the cost of studies, surveys, plans and specifications, and architectural, engineering, or other special services.
