## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A House Joint Resolution concerning

## 2 Centennial Anniversary of the Korean-American Community

- 3 FOR the purpose of requesting the Governor to designate this year as the Centennial
- 4 Anniversary of the Korean-American Community.
- 5 WHEREAS, In December 1902, a group of 56 men, 21 women, and 25 children
- 6 traveled from Korea across the Pacific Ocean, landing in Honolulu, Hawaii, on
- 7 January 13, 1903; and
- 8 WHEREAS, This event marked the first entry of Korean immigrants to United
- 9 States territory; and
- WHEREAS, Over the past century, Korean-Americans have demonstrated
- 11 initiative, creativity, and an affinity for hard work that has made them a vital,
- 12 successful, and growing part of American society and to the State of Maryland; and
- WHEREAS, With their history of great success in this country,
- 14 Korean-Americans continue to make vital contributions to the freedom and
- 15 prosperity enjoyed by all Americans; now, therefore, be it
- 16 RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the
- 17 General Assembly commemorate and designate the year 2003 as the centennial
- 18 anniversary of Korean-American immigration to the United States; and be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That the General Assembly encourage the citizens of the State to
- 20 learn more about, reflect on, and appreciate the unique and invaluable contributions
- 21 of Maryland's Korean-American community; and be it further
- 22 RESOLVED, That a copy of this Resolution be forwarded by the Department of
- 23 Legislative Services to the Honorable Robert L. Ehrlich, Jr., Governor of Maryland;
- 24 the Honorable Thomas V. Mike Miller, Jr., President of the Senate of Maryland; and
- 25 the Honorable Michael E. Busch, Speaker of the House of Delegates.
