2 Religious Freedom

- 3 FOR the purpose of resolving that a person who prays in a public place in Maryland
- 4 may properly refer to a particular deity or religious leader without being subject
- 5 to criticism or censure; and generally relating to religious freedom in Maryland.
- 6 WHEREAS, Article 36 of the Maryland Declaration of Rights provides for
- 7 freedom of religion in Maryland; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Maryland has a history of religious toleration and freedom; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The Constitution of the United States provides for freedom of 10 religion; and
- WHEREAS, The people of the State of Maryland respect religious diversity; now,
- 12 therefore, be it
- 13 RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That a person
- 14 who prays in a public place in Maryland may properly refer to a particular deity or
- 15 religious leader during that person's prayer; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That a person who refers to a particular deity or religious leader
- 17 during prayer in a public place in Maryland may not be subject to criticism or censure
- 18 because of the reference to a particular deity or religious leader; and be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That a copy of this Resolution be forwarded by the Department of
- 20 Legislative Services to the Honorable Robert L. Ehrlich, Jr., Governor of Maryland;
