- 3 FOR the purpose of recognizing, honoring, and expressing appreciation for the longest
- 4 serving Speaker of the House of Delegates in the State of Maryland, the
- 5 Honorable Casper R. Taylor, Jr.
- 6 WHEREAS, Casper R. Taylor, Jr., was elected to the House of Delegates in 1975; 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, Delegate Taylor served as chairman of the House Committee on
- 9 Economic Matters from 1987 to 1994; he was then elected Speaker of the House of
- 10 Delegates in January 1995 and continued to serve in that capacity until January
- 11 2003; and
- 12 WHEREAS, During his tenure as Speaker, Cas Taylor did much to preserve and
- 13 advance the House of Delegates as an institution by establishing The Speaker's
- 14 Society to recognize and memorialize the legacy of public service bestowed by the
- 15 current and former members of the House; by establishing the Speaker's Medallion as
- 16 an award given in recognition of an outstanding career of dedication and exemplary
- 17 service to the House and the State; by initiating the restoration of the historic lounge
- 18 of the House of Delegates; by incorporating modern technology into the floor
- 19 proceedings of the House; by initiating a highly successful motor bus orientation tour
- 20 of the State in the first year of a term for new members of the House; and, most
- 21 significantly, fostering, through his deliberative approach to issues and the

- 1 implementation of effective consensus building techniques, a climate of bipartisan
- 2 cooperation among the members of the House; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Under the leadership of Delegate Taylor in his capacity as Speaker

- 5 poorest jurisdictions, implementing the "One Maryland" approach to meeting some of

- 12 House Office Building is scheduled to begin in the Spring of 2003; and
