## **SENATE BILL 42**

1 (1) a person or governmental unit that is the subject of a public record or 2 a designee of the person or governmental unit;

3 (2) if the person has a legal disability, the parent or legal representative 4 of the person; or

5 (3) as to requests for correction of certificates of death under § 6 5-310(d)(2) of the Health - General Article, the spouse, adult child, parent, adult 7 sibling, grandparent, or guardian of the person of the deceased at the time of the 8 deceased's death.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2003.
