## 2 Education - High School Diplomas - World War II Veterans

- 3 FOR the purpose of allowing an honorably discharged veteran of World War II to
- 4 apply to certain county boards of education to obtain a high school diploma if the
- 5 individual withdrew from a certain full-time public or private school in the
- 6 individual's junior or senior year in certain circumstances; making this Act an
- 7 emergency measure; and generally relating to high school diplomas for World
- 8 War II veterans.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article - Education

17 7-206.1.

- 18 (a) (1) AN INDIVIDUAL HONORABLY DISCHARGED FROM MILITARY SERVICE
- 19 MAY APPLY TO OBTAIN A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA IF THE INDIVIDUAL WITHDREW
- 20 FROM A REGULAR FULL-TIME PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SCHOOL ACCREDITED BY THE
- 21 STATE BOARD DURING THE INDIVIDUAL'S JUNIOR OR SENIOR YEAR IN HIGH SCHOOL
- 22 TO ENLIST IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES DURING WORLD WAR II.
- 23 (2) An individual honorably discharged from military service may apply
- 24 to obtain a high school diploma if the individual withdrew from a regular full-time
- 25 public or private school accredited by the State Board during the individual's senior
- 26 year in high school to enlist in the armed forces of the United States during [World
- 27 War II or] the Korean Conflict.

- 1 (b) To obtain a high school diploma under subsection (a) of this section, the 2 individual shall apply to the county board in the county where the individual resides
- 3 or where the school from which the individual withdrew was located.
- 4 (c) Each county board shall adopt rules and regulations to establish
- 5 procedures for awarding diplomas under this section.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 7 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
- 8 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
- 9 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 10 the date it is enacted.
