

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 **Article - Public Safety** 15 14-109. Each political subdivision shall: 16 (a) 17 establish a local organization for emergency management in (1) 18 accordance with the State emergency management plan and program; and 19 participate in federal programs for emergency management.
