

7 Department of Budget and Finance to make that list available to the public; and
8 generally relating to property tax sales notices in Baltimore County the collector

places, notice of a tax sale of property at public auction; and generally relating to

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
19 Article - Tax - Property

21 (a) (1) At EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPHS (2), (3), AND (4) OF THIS
22 <u>SUBSECTION, AT</u> any time after 30 days from the mailing of the statement and notice,
23 the collector shall cause to be published, 4 times, once a week for 4 successive weeks

- 5 1. MAINTAIN A LIST OF PROPERTIES TO BE SOLD THAT
- 6 INCLUDES THE INFORMATION REQUIRED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION;
- 7 2. MAIL OR DELIVER, FREE OF COST, A COPY OF THE LIST TO
- 8 AN INDIVIDUAL, ON REQUEST; AND
- 9 3. POST THE LIST ON THE COUNTY'S WEBSITE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 11 October 1, 2003.
