SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OFMARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1, 1991, active duty with the commissioned corps of the Public Health Service, the
20 National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, or the Coast and Geodetic Survey

25 (e) "Regular interest":

28 (2) when used in relation to a local retirement or pension system, has the 29 meaning most closely analogous to the meaning stated in § 20-101 of this article 30 within the context of the local retirement or pension system.

(f) "State or local retirement or pension system" means a retirement or
 pension system operated under the laws of the State or a political subdivision of the

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1(g)"State system" means a retirement or pension system that is included in2the State Retirement and Pension System under § 21-102 of this article other than

3 the Legislative Pension Plan except to the extent provided by the joint resolution4 submitted to the General Assembly by the General Assembly Compensation

5 Commission under Article III, § 15 of the Maryland Constitution.

7 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a member of a State 8 system, who has not met the conditions set forth in § 38-103(a)(2) through (4) of this 9 subtitle, is entitled to receive service credit for military service only on the attainment 10 of 10 years of creditable service.			
 (b) (1) A member of a State system may not receive credit for that military service if the member receives credit for military service from another retirement system for which retirement benefits have been or will be received by the member.

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 October 1, 2003.

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
