5 (2) ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 2008 PRIOR TO RETIREMENT, AND SUBJECT
6 TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A MEMBER WHO RECEIVES SERVICE
7 CREDIT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL DEPOSIT IN THE ANNUITY SAVINGS FUND
8 OR OTHER CORRESPONDING FUND AN AMOUNT OF MONEY EQUAL TO THE
9 CONTRIBUTION PAYMENTS THAT THE MEMBER AND THE EMPLOYER WOULD HAVE
