19 20	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
23	(2) "COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDER" MEANS A COMMUNITY-BASED MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OR AN INDIVIDUAL PRACTITIONER WHO CONTRACTS WITH THE DEPARTMENT OR THE APPROPRIATE CORE SERVICE AGENCY.

 CONSUMERS" PUBLISHED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR THE
 WASHINGTON-BALTIMORE METROPOLITAN AREA; AND

17(2)THE ANNUAL RATE OF CHANGE MAY NOT EXCEED A MAXIMUM RATE18 OF 5%.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectJuly 1, 2003.
