3 FOR the purpose of altering the Maryland migratory game bird stamp required to be

- 4 purchased by a person hunting migratory game birds; requiring a person to

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
