### 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

However, a master hunting guide 21 shall register with the Department each agent, employee, or helper of the master 22 hunting guide who is a field assistant.] 23 To apply for a license as a [master hunting guide] WATERFOWL (d) (1)24 OUTFITTER OR A WATERFOWL HUNTING GUIDE, an applicant shall: 25 Submit an application to [any person designated by] the (i) 26 Department; 27 (ii) Furnish any information required by the Department on the 28 application, including the oath provided in subsection (e) of this section; and 29 Pay to the [person designated to issue the master hunting (iii) 30 guide license] DEPARTMENT a fee of [\$100] \$500 FOR A WATERFOWL OUTFITTER 31 LICENSE OR \$100 FOR A WATERFOWL HUNTING GUIDE LICENSE. 32 [(2)]As compensation for issuing the license, the designated person shall 33 retain 25 cents of each \$100 fee received under this section. 34 On the first day of each month, the designated person shall send to (3)35 the Department the remainder of the fees received for master hunting guide 36 licenses.]
