4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the student member of the New Prince George's County Board of Education to vote on certain matters; authorizing the New Prince George's County Board of Education to determine if the student member of the Board may vote on certain matters; and generally relating to the authority of the student member of the New Prince George's County Board of Education to vote on matters before the Prince George's Regional Association of Student Governments to establish procedures for the election of the student member; clarifying that certain provisions apply to appointed members of the Board; clarifying that a certain compensation provision does not apply to the student member; clarifying the term of the student member; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the New Prince George's County Board of Education.


