- (d) (1) The Board shall elect one of its members as chairman, one as vice 2 chairman, and one as treasurer. 3 [Seventeen members of the Board constitute a quorum, but action 4 may not be taken by less than the vote of nine members] A MAJORITY OF THE 5 MEMBERS OF THE BOARD THEN SERVING CONSTITUTE A QUORUM. 6 A vacancy in the membership of the Board of Directors does not 7 impair the right of a quorum of the Board of Directors to exercise all rights and 8 perform all the duties of the Corporation. 9 The Board shall appoint an executive committee and may appoint (4) 10 such other committees as the Board deems necessary or desirable. 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the 12 individuals initially serving on the Board of Directors in new positions established by 13 this Act shall expire as follows: 14 (1) two members in 2004; 15 two members in 2005; and (2)16 one member in 2006. (3) 17 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an 18 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health
- 19 or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the
- 20 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take
- 21 effect from the date it is enacted.
