A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Court of Appeals of Maryland - State Board of Law Examiners -**
3 **Examination Fee**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the amount that the Court of Appeals of Maryland may
5 set as an examination fee payable to the State Board of Law Examiners by an
6 applicant for admission to the Bar of the Court of Appeals of Maryland; and
7 generally relating to an examination fee for an applicant for admission to the
8 Bar.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
10 Article - Business Occupations and Professions
11 Section 10-208(b)
12 Annotated Code of Maryland
13 (2000 Replacement Volume and 2002 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions**

17 10-208.

18 (b) An applicant shall pay to the Board:

19 (1) an examination fee not exceeding [\\$150] \$325, as set by the Court of
20 Appeals; and

21 (2) any other fee set by the Court of Appeals.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
23 effect July 1, 2003.
