
A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Task Force to Study Health Regulations for Bed and Breakfast Operators

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study Health Regulations for Bed
- 4 and Breakfast Operators; providing for the composition, chairman, and staff of
- 5 the Task Force; providing that the members of the Task Force may not receive
- 6 compensation, but may be reimbursed for certain expenses; providing for the
- duties of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to report to the Governor and
- 8 to the General Assembly by a certain date; providing for the termination of this
- 9 Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to Study Health Regulations for
- 10 Bed and Breakfast Operators.
- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That:
- 13 (a) There is a Task Force to Study Health Regulations for Bed and Breakfast
- 14 Operators.
- 15 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- 16 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President
- 17 of the Senate;
- 18 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of
- 19 the House;
- 20 (3) the Secretary of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation,
- 21 or the Secretary's designee;
- 22 (4) the Secretary of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, or
- 23 the Secretary's designee;
- 24 (5) one representative of a local department of health, appointed by the
- 25 Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene;
- 26 (6) the chairman of the Maryland Tourism Development Board, or the
- 27 chairman's designee;
