## 2 Harford County - County Board of Education and Superintendent of Schools

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that the procedures for the appointment or
- 4 reappointment of the Harford County Superintendent of Schools are those that

- 6 Harford County Board of Education provide public notice that the county board
- 7 will conduct an evaluation of the county superintendent of schools by a specific
- 8 date; repealing the requirement that the county board conduct an evaluation of
- 9 the county superintendent and share the findings of the evaluation with the
- 10 county superintendent by a certain date; repealing the county superintendent's
- reappointment notification requirement to the county board; and generally

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3	(b) (1) The term of a county superintendent is 4 years beginning on July 1. A county superintendent continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.		
	(2) [Except in Harford County, by] BY February 1 of the year in which a term ends, the county superintendent shall notify the county board whether the superintendent is a candidate for reappointment.		
10	8 (3) In the year in which a term begins, the county board shall appoint a 9 county superintendent between February 1 and June 30. However, if the county board 10 decides to reappoint the incumbent superintendent, the county board shall take final 11 action at a public meeting no later than March 1 of that year.		
	(4) If a county board is unable to appoint a county superintendent by July 1 of a year in which a term begins, the provisions of subsection (d) of this section apply.		
15	[(5) (i) This paragraph applies only to Harford County.		
18 19	16 (ii) By January 1 of the year that is 2 years before the county 17 superintendent's term ends, and by January 1 of the year that the superintendent's 18 term ends, the Harford County Board shall provide public notice in 2 newspapers of 19 general circulation in the county that the Board will conduct an evaluation of the 20 superintendent's professional performance.		
21 22	(iii) By February 1 of each year specified in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, the Harford County Board shall:		
23 24	1. Conduct an evaluation of the county superintendent's professional performance; and		
25 26	2. Share the findings of the evaluation with the county superintendent.		
29 30	(iv) 1. By December 1 of the year preceding a year in which the term ends, the county superintendent shall notify the county Board whether the superintendent is a candidate for reappointment. If the superintendent notifies the county Board that the superintendent is not a candidate for reappointment, then the remaining provisions of this paragraph shall not apply.		
	2. The county Board shall provide public notice in 2 newspapers of general circulation in the county whether the superintendent is a candidate for reappointment.]
