1 AN ACT concerning

Homicide by Aggressive Driving

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the crime of homicide by aggressive driving for a

- 4 person who commits at least a certain number of motor vehicle violations in
- 5 connection with a single traffic incident that results in the death of another
- 6 person; specifying certain motor vehicle violations to which the crime of
- 7 homicide by aggressive driving applies; providing for certain penalties;
- 8 providing for certain procedures in a prosecution for homicide by aggressive
- 9 driving; requiring a clerk of a court to notify the Motor Vehicle Administration of
- 10 a person convicted of homicide by aggressive driving; providing for the
- 11 assessment of points by the Administration for a conviction for the crime of
- 12 homicide by aggressive driving; defining a certain term; and generally relating
- 13 to establishing the crime of homicide by aggressive driving.

25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

6 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT IN THE PENITENTIARY NOT
7 EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.

9 (A) AN INDICTMENT OR OTHER CHARGING DOCUMENT FOR HOMICIDE BY 10 AGGRESSIVE DRIVING IS SUFFICIENT IF IT SUBSTANTIALLY STATES:

"(NAME OF DEFENDANT) ON (DATE) IN (COUNTY) COMMITTED HOMICIDE BY
 AGGRESSIVE DRIVING BY KILLING (NAME OF VICTIM) AGAINST THE PEACE,
 GOVERNMENT, AND DIGNITY OF THE STATE. ".

14 (B) AN INDICTMENT OR OTHER CHARGING DOCUMENT FOR HOMICIDE BY 15 AGGRESSIVE DRIVING NEED NOT SET FORTH THE MANNER OR MEANS OF DEATH.

16 (C) IN A CASE IN A CIRCUIT COURT IN WHICH THE GENERAL FORM OF
17 INDICTMENT OR OTHER CHARGING DOCUMENT IS USED TO CHARGE AN OFFENSE
18 UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE DEFENDANT, ON TIMELY DEMAND, IS ENTITLED TO A
19 BILL OF PARTICULARS.
