5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF6 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "QUALIFIED HYBRID VEHICLE" HAS THE MEANING 20 STATED IN § 13-815(A)(6) OF THIS ARTICLE.

(B) A QUALIFIED HYBRID VEHICLE IS EXEMPT FROM THE MANDATORY TESTS
22 AND INSPECTIONS REQUIRED BY THIS SUBTITLE IF THE VEHICLE OBTAINS A RATING
23 FROM THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY OF AT LEAST 50 MILES PER
24 GALLON DURING CITY FUEL ECONOMY TESTS.

25 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO 26 IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

28 October 1, 2003. It shall remain effective for a period of four 3 years and, at the end of

29 September 30, 2007 2006, with no further action required by the General Assembly,

30 this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
