2 Jury Duty - Excuse from Service - Breastfeeding Mother

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a judge to excuse from jury service a mother who is
- 4 breastfeeding a child under the age of 2 years.
- 5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 12 Article Courts and Judicial Proceedings
- 13 8-210.
- 14 (a) (1) Any person summoned for jury service may be excused by the jury
- 15 judge if the person shows that undue hardship, extreme inconvenience, or public
- 16 necessity require his excuse, but only for the period the jury judge deems necessary.
- 17 At the conclusion of this period the person shall be summoned again for jury service
- 18 under the provisions of § 8-208 of this title.
- 19 (2) A MOTHER WHO IS BREASTFEEDING A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 2
- 20 YEARS SHALL BE EXCUSED FROM JURY SERVICE BY THE JURY JUDGE.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 22 effect October 1, 2003.
