11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Election Law

15 (b) Subject to subsection (d) of this section, a person may not, either directly or 16 indirectly, in an election cycle make:

- 17 (1) aggregate contributions in excess of:
- 18 (i) \$4,000 to any one campaign finance entity; or
- 19 (ii) [\$10,000]\$20,000 to all campaign finance entities; or
- 20 (2) a contribution of money in excess of \$100 except by check.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 2003.
